This new Beaune based negociant firm was founded by Mounir Saouma, a Lebanese immigrant. Saouma moved from war torn Lebanon to a Cistercian monastery in Israel. There, during his six years at the monastery, he worked in the winery, was bitten by the wine bug and left to study wine at the University at Montpellier, France. Saouma only works with small lots (there are no more than three barrels of any one wine), They are all purchased as wine, aged in 100% new Seguin-Moreau oak barrels, have their lees stirred regularly and bottled with neither fining or filtration. RUBBERNECK WINES

This Monterey County winery in California's Central Coast area produces artisanal wines from Central Coast grape varieties. Their wines deliver in both quality and price.

In addition, Barnett Vineyards produces limited amounts of Merlot, Pinot Noir from the sought after Goldridge soils of the Russian River and Chardonnay grown from single vineyards located in well-desired appellations.
